**SIXTH ANNUAL EAGLEBANK FOUNDATION
FIGHT BREAST CANCER GOLF CLASSIC RAISES OVER \$266,000**

BETHESDA, MD. This year represented EagleBank Foundation's sixth year of sponsoring the Fight Breast Cancer Golf Classic for the benefit of local area hospitals and organizations in their fight against breast cancer. Since the first golf tournament in 2005, we have raised over \$915,000.
